Interstate

DRIVERS LICENCES

Interstate

To obtain a South Australian drivers licence, present to the Council office with your current interstate licence, written evidence of your new residential address and another form of personal identification.
You will be required to complete a form, pay a fee and surrender your interstate licence.
This service is only available on Wednesdays and Thursdays from 9am – 4:30pm.

It is a requirement to pass a theory test to obtain your South Australian licence.
This test is available at the Council office, Wednesdays and Thursday's only from 9am – 4pm.

VEHICLE REGISTRATION

To transfer your vehicle to South Australian registration, you will need to attend the Council office on Wednesdays or Thursdays from 9am – 4:30pm.
You will be required to present the current registration documentation or undergo a vehicle inspection by the local police.
Stamp duty and the new registration fee will be payable.
